PROFESSIONAL OVERVIEW

She provides hazardous waste training as a part of the EHS training curriculum.

Chemical disclosures involve reviewing quantities of hazardous materials and their associated hazards, preparing business emergency plans, and preparing maps to display hazardous material storage, emergency equipment, and evacuation routes.
